



## New Jerusalem: A city without walls and no temple

**Zechariah 2** vs 4-5 "Run, tell that young man, 'Jerusalem will be a city without walls because of the great number of people and animals in it. And I myself will be a wall of fire around it,' declares the LORD, 'and I will be its glory within."

1 Peter 2 vs 4-5 "As you come to him, the living Stone--rejected by men but chosen by God and precious to him - you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ."

**Introduction**: What would the "new normal" look like" the post COVID-19, new BRUC?

**Invitation:** Please share your thoughts and comments.

### **Some Characteristics:**

Living stone/Cornerstone is Christ: This entails we need to make a continuous choice. Time and time again for Christ, to come to Him, return to Him. To be a distinct community, to live as strangers (1:17). To depart from the worldly ways, to Holy (1:13-16), to love deeply (1:22); to be born again (2:2); to grow (2:2).

As Livings stones we are to be build up into a spiritual house" The verb "built up" is in a medium form, meaning it is not passive, neither active on our own, but together with God.

A spiritual house with no walls. No walls for protection. No walls to exclude. No boundaries of locality, of colour, of language, of denomination. A spiritual house for all nations. As resident aliens in this world we are built into a home for the homeless, a welcome haven for the stranger, a retreat for the seeker.

Calling to proclaim (2 vs 9) Because we are recipients of God's mercy, a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God - our calling is to praise the might acts of God. To witness, to proclaim His mercy. His dwelling with humankind.

**Run**, tell that young man God has aroused Himself and is coming to build a city with no walls, no temple. It is done. I am the Alpha and Omega!

### The Way

After reviewing many scholarly attempts to discover the historical Jesus, Albert Schweitzer, in his book, The Quest of the Historical Jesus, wrote, "He comes to us as One unknown, without a name, as of old, by the lakeside, He came to those men who knew Him not. He speaks to us the same words: "Follow thou me!" and sets us to the tasks which He has to fulfill for our time.

He commands. And to those who obey Him, whether they be wise or simple, He will reveal himself in the toils, the conflicts, the sufferings which they shall pass through in His fellowship, and, as an ineffable mystery, they shall learn in their own experience Who He is." And in learning who he is we learn who God is. God who comes to us beyond description, beyond definition is revealed to us as we worship, obey, trust and serve in an on-going divine-human relationship.

Jesus is our doorway to this One. He is the road that leads us into an ever-deepening relationship with the Father. John 14:16: "I am in the Father, and the Father is in me." If you want to know what God is like, look at Jesus presented to us in the pages of Scripture.

If you want to live in an on-going relationship with God, do it through a trust-filled relationship with the living Lord Jesus Christ. To know Jesus is to know God: to know God is to know Jesus. Through this one, our fellow human being, we are invited into God's eternal realm of joy, peace, justice, truth and love, and he assures us that there is no shortage of accommodation there (John 14:2). There is always room for one more.

- What have you learnt of Jesus through the Bible?
- What have you learnt of Jesus through your own experience?
- What does it mean to come to the Father by way of Jesus?
- Compare this interpretation of John 14:2 with that used at funerals.

#### **BLUE CARD FORMS**

Applying for or renewing Blue Cards during COVID-19 With self-isolation in place and many businesses closed or limited, accessing a Justice of the Peace (JP) for the signing of blue cards may be difficult at this time.

Blue Card Services has advised that any serving Police Officer can sign Blue Cards instead of a JP. This option should minimise the difficulty around applying for or renewing a Blue Card during this period.

Please remember that volunteers must not start volunteering in child-related activities until they have received their positive notice.

Blue Card Services have stated on their website that you can continue to use the forms which show an expiry date of 30 March 2020 until they notify us otherwise.
