## We are seekers Focus texts: Acts 17:27 & 1 Peter 3:15

**Seekers**: Humans are seekers. We seek meaning of life, purpose of living. We seek the Divine, the Other (Acts 17:27; Ecclesiastes 23:10-11; Proverbs8:17). Modern persons are also seeking, particularly now, when world views and normal securities & perspectives have been shaken, even turned upside down.

**Church's Mission**: Is to give account of our faith. To be witnesses of what we have received – grace. Definitive of our faith is the Easter story – the crucifixion and resurrection of Christ. The ascension and reign of Christ. We confess a living God. We live with the gift of a living hope.

Our missional is not confrontational or judgmental. It is to be ready and able to give account of our faith —a t all times to each and every one asking! To live what we are: God's people; God's elect; a holy nation; a royal priesthood; recipients of the gifts of grace, faith, love and hope. To give account with gentleness and respect, with consideration and reverence.

**Parakletos**: We are not alone. We need not fear. Go has given us the gift of the *para-kletos*, the One who calls alongside us, with us. The Holy Spirit, the Advocate, the Counsellor. The Holy Spirit will teach you and guide you – that is the promise, the truth.

The church has been tasked with the message of Easter, even though few may respond, we remain accountable to give witness, to be evidence of God's mercy and grace. The church does not possess salvation; but we carry the message of salvation and are ourselves the object of salvation. This is our mission, our calling to each and every one seeking.

### **Our Unseen Friend**

John 14:15-21

You have a job to be done, but you don't have the skills or the time to do it yourself. What do you do? If possible, you get someone who is skilled and available to do it for you. For example, if summonsed to court, you get a lawyer to speak for you. Well, think of this. God needed human assistance in restoring the world to its intended state of goodness, integrity, right relationships, peace and justice, so asked Jesus to accomplish it.

Or, to put it differently, God called on his Son to release people from the alienation and rebellion that prevented them from being the people God wanted them to be. It was not an easy task for to do this he had to come into inevitable collision with entrenched power structures and puffed up egos that human sinfulness had created. However, he gathered a following. In particular, he gathered a group of disciples with whom he shared his message.

Before he was killed, he called on them to continue the task that he had begun. He knew that this was beyond their capabilities, but assured them that they would not be left to do it all on their own. As he had been God's agent in drawing people into the kingdom of God, so the Holy Spirit would continue this work in and through them.

The Spirit would, for all of Christ's disciples, be the friend to assist them in their living, their understanding and in the great mission entrusted to them. So, for us, called to be part of this divine enterprise, we are given a counsellor, advocate, comforter, assistant or friend to help us. (The Greek word parakletos used in John 14:16 can be translated in all of these ways) oly Spirit ios
