# **Christian Unity**

John 17:6-19

In a world of individualism, it might be hard to grasp hold of the concept of mutual indwelling. In a close, warm, intimate relationship, the people concerned do not remain entirely independent entities. Spiritually they merge. Maybe not without interruption for they remain two separate individuals, but something of the one dwells in the other. Thomas Aquinas used the term 'mutual indwelling' to describe this in his study of friendship.

In John 17 we see this in relation to God the Father and Jesus the Son – a mutual indwelling. But that is not all. We hear Jesus talking about a mutual indwelling of Jesus and his disciples, as in John 15 when we hear Jesus calling his disciples to abide in him as he abides in them. So Jesus prayed for his disciples that they might be one as he and the Father are one. The unity of the Church is always dependent upon the mutual indwelling of Christ in the Church and the Church in Christ.

The path to Christian unity does not lie through organization or planning, negotiation or conformity, similarity or shared heritage. Unity is the spiritual reality present when Christians dwell in Christ and Christ dwells in them. It is when we recognize Christ in the other believer. Our unity is firmly set in Christ. It is only as we interact at more than a superficial level that we recognize that unity. The big thing that the Ecumenical Movement did was to bring Christians together from different denominations, there to discover the unity we share in Christ.
