WELCOME TO WORSHIP

*****LECTIONARY THEMES*****

God the Holy Trinity

Romans 8:12-17

I don't know how much thought you have given to the concept of mutual indwelling. It describes the spiritual experience of intimacy with another person. Something of you dwells in me and something of me abides in you. It describes the intimacy of deep, inter-personal, lasting, relationship, and Jesus invites us into this relationship with himself when he says "Abide in me as I abide in you." Jesus described his relationship with the Father as a mutual indwelling: "As you, Father are in me and I am in you." So, we see God, The Trinity, as a mutual indwelling of Father, Son and Holy Spirit – three, but one.

Jesus said that God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth – those who think of him must think in terms of spirit and truth. That means, not in terms of mathematics or of physicality. The power of being or the power behind existence, is the power that communicates and also the power that brings about change, but these are not three independent spiritual forces, they are known to us in their mutual indwelling. We call them Father, Son and Holy Spirit – three, but one.

- By what other names do we know God the Father?
- By what other names do we know God the Son?
- By what other names do we know God the Holy Spirit?
- The doctrine of the Trinity is not, as such, taught in the Bible, but there are hints there. What hints do you find in Romans 8:12-17?
