#### Laws for Life

\*\*\*LECTIONARY THEMES\*\*\*

#### Mark 10:2-16

There is justice and there is a justice system – two different things. Similarly there is the spirit of the law and there is the letter of the law – two different things. One can keep the letter of the law while not keeping the spirit of the law and sometimes one can be true to the spirit of the law without actually keeping the letter of the law. This is true of all law whether it be state law, religious law or moral law.

For the ancient Jewish people their Torah combined all three and was at the very heart of their national, religious and community life. Jesus, however, rebuked the religious leaders of his time for straining to keep the letter of the law while avoiding the spirit of the law. This comes up particularly in relation to laws about the Sabbath.

But there is another distinction to be made: some laws are basic, giving voice to God's fundamental intention while others are concessions to human weakness. The difference is brought out in Jesus' conversation with Pharisees over the issue of divorce. He pointed out that divorce laws were only made necessary because of human weakness – sinfulness. God's real intention is that the marriage relationship be an enduring one. Over the centuries the role of marriage in society has changed but the fundamental 'law' still stands.

Marriage is meant to be for life. That's the most important rule, but because of our flawed human nature we also need to allow for the possibility of divorce. However we must keep the proper proportion: aim always for the law which states God's fundamental intention even when the concessional laws have to come into play.

- How helpful is it to make a distinction between fundamental laws and concessional laws in our understanding of God's will?
- What are God's fundamental laws by which all the others should be interpreted? How can they help in our thinking about marriage and divorce?
- What part does law play in the living of the Christian life?
- How relevant to the current discussion about same-sex marriage is Mark 10:1-12?
