# **Christian Unity**

John 17:20-26

What do we pray for when we pray for Christian unity? That all Christians will think alike? Of course not. They never have, and the God who created so much diversity could hardly want that. That all denominations will merge into one great super-church? Hardly.

The Bible passage that provides the basis for our prayers for Christian unity is John 17:20-26. According to that passage, Jesus prayed that both the disciples that he had gathered around him during his lifetime and all those who later would believe in him through their testimony would be one. He prayed that they should form a unity with himself as an extension of the unity that he had with his Father. Clearly it is a spiritual unity; an intimate, interactive relationship of love.

As God the Father is present in Jesus the Son, so he is present in his followers. Together they form a unity. We give expression to this when we partake of the bread and wine at Communion.

So our prayer for Christian unity should be, first of all, a prayer for a deeper relationship with Christ on the part of all Christians. Christian unity is based on our oneness with Christ, not on creeds or doctrine, forms of worship, Apostolic Succession or unified organization.

John Wesley spoke about our union in affection. He said that Christians can be of one heart though not of one opinion, and that is the unity that he encouraged in his sermon entitled, *The Catholic Spirit*. The centre around which Christian unity exists is Jesus the Christ. Around this centre much diversity exists, but in our relationship with this centre we find ourselves at one with others who also live in a vital relationship with Jesus Christ.

#### Psalm 36 and a Russian prayer for Animals

Your love, LORD, reaches to the heavens, your faithfulness to the skies.

Your righteousness is like the highest mountains, your justice like the great deep.

### You, LORD, preserve both people and animals.

<sup>7</sup>How priceless is your unfailing love, O God!

People take refuge in the shadow of your wings. Psalm 36 starts with the deeds of evil and wicked persons, and in the middle of the psalm is this incredible confession

of God's love for persons and animals.

Russia is presently remembered by many for the incomprehensible attack on Ukraine. However, I thought to share this Russian prayer for animals, loosely translated by me from an Afrikaans translation!

> "Bless this day, O Lord, and all who live today across this wide world. Bless every piece of your beautiful creation.

O let the flowers and fruit and corn bloom and reach out to you who enable them to grow.

O Lord, saturate the earth with your goodness!

O bless the years that lie ahead -

May we live each day to your honour and glory.

O Lord, as you bless people bless also the humble beasts and other living creatures

that live on earth, and in the air, and under the water. You created them so beautiful and strong and clever.

Think of the animals that we harness to work for us.

Protect them against heat and rain.

Please provide food and shelter

to those that we neglect.

Great is your mercy –

O Saviour of the world,

please do not forget one of your creatures."
