Religious Instruction in the media

RI has been in the media a fair bit this year. We are very happy to let you know that in the past couple of days there have been a couple of opportunities for us to present our side of the story.

We hope that you can take the time to read and listen to these media stories as they will help inform you about how you can answer this question: 'Why should RI stay in curriculum time?' when you speak with family and friends.

Following is a summary of the main points from our Chairperson Karen Grenning:

- *Moving RI out of curriculum time would effectively result in the end of the RI program, resulting in parents missing out on an important aspect of education for their children.
- *We don't want to extend school hours (by moving RI to before or after school, or to the lunch break).

Prayers by Dr Martin Luther King Jnr

We also pray for Thy holy Church universal; that it may be so guided and governed by Thy Spirit, that all who profess and call themselves Christians may be led into the way of truth, and hold the faith in unity of spirit, in the bond of peace, and in righteousness of life. Finally, we commend to Thy Fatherly goodness all those who are in any way afflicted or distressed in mind or body. Give them patience under the suffering and power of endurance. This we ask in the name of Jesus. Amen.

Prayer to forgive us for what we could have been but failed to be

O Thou Eternal God, out of whose absolute power and infinite intelligence the whole universe has come into being, we humbly confess that we have not loved thee with our hearts, souls and minds, and we have not loved our neighbours as Christ loved us. We have all too often lived by our own selfish impulses rather than by the life of sacrificial love as revealed by Christ. We often give in order to receive. We love our friends and hate our enemies. We go the first mile but dare not travel the second. We forgive but dare not forget. And so as we look within ourselves, we are confronted with the appalling fact that the history of our lives is the history of an eternal revolt against you. But thou, O God, have mercy upon us. Forgive us for what we could have been but failed to be. Give us the intelligence to know your will. Give us the courage to do your will. Give us the devotion to love thy will. In the name and spirit of Jesus we pray. Amen.

*Those not opted into RI do valuable curriculum-based learning which may include revision and quiet reading
*A modern inclusive education system has RI in curriculum time.

*Both Karen and Rev David Baker rejected the idea that we are indoctrinating children, and argued that Christian RI gives students the opportunity to question, explore and discover the Christian faith for themselves.
