UPDATE FROM FDG

The Future Directions Group met recently and made a number of recommendations to Church Council regarding the proposals that have been approved in principle by Presbytery in 2023. As follows:

- Labyrinth and Gallery Ramp at Montville, and the Online Engagement proposals to proceed to implementation phase in 2024.
- Palmwoods Hub, the Children's & Families Worker and the Community Chaplain to be held over until after the consultation and proposed appointment of a new Minister.
- a number of Missional Activities for individual locations emerged during the FDG process. These have been referred to Kay at Palmwoods and to the Maleny Mission Team (MMT) for development.
- Consultation: it was agreed that the valuable work completed by the Mission Task Group and the Future Directions Group (2022, 2023) be referred to the Consultation Team.

This now completes the tasks delegated to the FDG, hence the FDG has been dissolved.

The FDG thanks all members of the Blackall Range Congregation for your diligence and earnest, prayerful discernment over the past two years.
