MONTVILLE REFLECTION GALLERY DISPLAY

Today we installed Dr Gregg Nowell's Stations of the Cross series in the Reflection Gallery. The Stations of the Cross sequence is that traditionally followed in the Roman Catholic Church and takes the viewer through the arrest, trial, suffering and death of Jesus with the inclusion of his resurrection.

The pictures in this new display lend themselves to quiet reflection as visitors have to move in close to see them.

In addition to the Stations of the Cross, Gregg has hung a large abstract painting above the pulpit.



Led by the Act2 Project, Uniting in Prayer is a national Uniting Church prayer event to take place between Pentecost and the 47th Uniting Church Anniversary (19 May – 22 June 2024).

As discernment continues about future directions for the Uniting Church, this is a time to come together in thanksgiving and hope, in openness to the Holy Spirit.

For 35 days we'll share in daily prayers from across our Church, gather for prayer and worship and pray for each other through a national prayer chain which will connect every Uniting Church community to others.
