Church Council met last Monday. As usual the meeting was very collegial with some important items to discuss. Rev George Woodward (chair) opens with a devotion and prayer before we move into business. Some of the business discussed –

John Daniel's resignation from Council and Presbytery Representative – with great regret, Council accepted John's resignation. In doing so, Council expressed deep gratitude and thanked John for his many years of dedicated service to our congregation.

Structure of Council – decided to recruit a Co-Chair and a new Presbytery representative to fill casual vacancies.

Consultation Update – we expect the report over the next few weeks. Our report has been held up by a couple of urgent matters in the Presbytery.

Finances – this period, we have made a very small surplus.

Administrative Matters – the Council agreed the Safe Church Resolution renewal; a process for updating the membership roll; reviewing Hall Hire Guidelines; and reviewing the Key Register.
