FINAL ACT2 REPORT RELEASED

The final report of the Act2 Project, Act2: *The Gift of the Spirit*, has now been released and will be considered as part of the 17th Assembly of the Uniting Church, to be held from 11 to 16 July. This is the most significant piece of work on the life and future of the Uniting Church since union in 1977. It follows four years of work which began in March 2020 and included an intensive period of exploration and discernment over the past 18 months.
