## FINAL ACT2 REPORT RELEASED

The final report of the Act2 Project, Act2: *The Gift of the Spirit*, has now been released and will be considered as part of the 17<sup>th</sup> Assembly of the Uniting Church, to be held from 11 to 16 July. This is the most significant piece of work on the life and future of the Uniting Church since union in 1977. It follows four years of work which began in March 2020 and included an intensive period of exploration and discernment over the past 18 months.

## VISION RADIO

There is a Christian radio station that broadcasts to Maleny and Palmwoods on 87.6FM as well as to 800 locations throughout Australia. Many of the regional stations (like Maleny and Palmwoods) are low power and only reach about 5km from the broadcast point. The stations broadcast 24 hours daily, all days. The content can also be heard on your smartphone using the Vision Christian Media App or on your computer from <https://vision.org.au/> (choose Listen in the top line menu and choose between Vision Radio, V180 Radio or Kids Radio).

Vision also has a prayer line available 9am to 7pm Monday to Friday available on 1800772936.

Vision have been raising funds for their work, aiming to raise \$2,000,000 to keep their operations going and expand their network. Vision is a non-profit, non-denominational, crowd-funded multimedia Christian ministry that is dedicated to ensuring God's Word continues to have a place in Australia's media landscape.
