SAFETY in our Churches is everyone's responsibility .. SPEAK UP!

This week, I'm focusing on 'near misses' .. Near misses (or close calls) are events that didn't harm anyone - but could have.

They are not accidents, but they could be accidents if the circumstances had been slightly different. Near misses happen more often than you might think because they are easy to forget

It's important to register near misses because these could prevent someone from getting hurt in the future.
